Sub : Installation of Universal Forwarder (UF) and assessed of Web Application

Madam / Sir,

Department of IT&E, GoWB has setup a Next Generation Cyber Security Operation Center (WB-NGSOC) at 4th floor of Monibhandar building, Salt Lake for monitoring security events and analyse anomalous activity on networks, servers, virtual machines, databases, applications, middleware, websites, and other systems & devices for early detection of a security incident or compromise.

The West Bengal NGSOC is responsible for ensuring that potential security incidents are correctly identified, analysed, investigated, and reported.

To ensure that all event logs are collected by WB-NGSOC, it's mandatory for all Departments / Directorate / Corporation running their applications from WBSDC Virtual Machine (VM) and collected system to install and configure an agent named "Splunk Universal Forwarder" which will send event logs to Splunk SIEM installed at WB-NGCSOC for necessary indexing, consolidation and correlation.

It is hereby requested to all the Department / Directorate / Corporation to facilitate installation and configuration of the agent mentioned above by contacting the below mentioned SPOC from WB-NGCSOC team for onboarding their ICT systems to WB-NGCSOC.



It is also requested that any new web applications must first be assessed for vulnerabilities by WB-NGCSOC team and will be onboarded to SDC production environment only if there are no critical vulnerabilities. Existing web Application must be assessed for vulnerabilities through WB-NGSOC.

Requested to all the Department / Directorate / Corporation running their applications from WBSDC must ensure compliance of the guidelines mentioned above.


